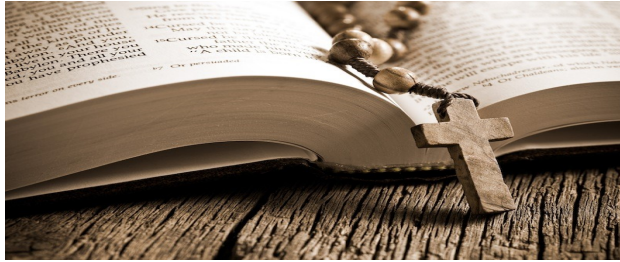

SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: Psalm 14:1-7

✓To the Choirmaster. Of David. ¹The fool says in his heart, "There is no God."
