## SERMON NOTES + MISCELLANEOUS

**TITLE:** "Summer In The Psalter: A Call To Get Involved"

**SCRIPTURE PASSAGE: Psalm 17:1-15**

**1A Prayer of David.** <sup>1</sup>Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry! Give ear to my prayer from lips free of deceit! <sup>2</sup>From your presence let my vindication come! Let your eyes behold the right! <sup>3</sup>You have tried my heart, you have visited me by night, you have tested me, and you will find nothing; I have purposed that my mouth will not transgress. <sup>4</sup>With regard to the works of man, by the word of your lips I have avoided the ways of the violent. <sup>5</sup>My steps have held fast to your paths; my feet have not slipped. <sup>6</sup>I call upon you, for you will answer me, O God; incline your ear to me; hear my words. <sup>7</sup>Wondrously show your steadfast love, O Savior of those who seek refuge from their adversaries at your right hand. <sup>8</sup>Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings, <sup>9</sup>from the wicked who do me violence, my deadly enemies who surround me. <sup>10</sup>They close their hearts to pity; with their mouths they speak arrogantly. <sup>11</sup>They have now surrounded our steps; they set their eyes to cast us to the ground. <sup>12</sup>He is like a lion eager to tear, as a young lion lurking in ambush. <sup>13</sup>Arise, O Lord! Confront him, subdue him! Deliver my soul from the wicked by your sword, <sup>14</sup>from men by your hand, O Lord, from men of the world whose portion is in this life. You fill their womb with treasure; they are satisfied with children, and they leave their abundance to their infants. <sup>15</sup>As for me, I shall behold your face in righteousness; when I awake, I shall be satisfied with your likeness."
